If you have personal information updates such as change of address, G.W.R.R.A. membership plan status, or other changes I believe you still need to update that yourself. Check with your Chapter Directors on those updates.

Here at N-2, we have started the year off with our first Education opportunity. On January 13th, five members took the CPR/AED/First Aid Refresher Course. I am hoping to set up a Parking Lot Practice in February followed up by an ERC course in March. No dates have been confirmed at this time, but I will keep you posted. I will try to give everyone more notice on these activities than was able to on the CPR Course. Until next time.

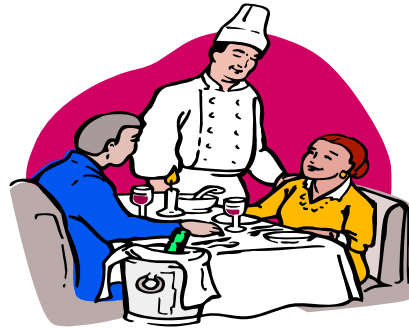

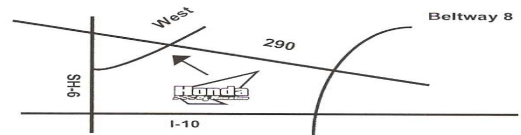
