80% of all crashes are directly related to DRIVER INATTENTION.

65% of all near crashes are directly related to DRIVER INATTENTION.

39% of all Highway deaths are alcohol related.

13% of Highway Deaths are speed related.

Chances of being in an Accident:

Increase 4 times when drowsy.

Increase 9 times reaching for objects or adjusting the radio.

Increase 3 times when talking on the phone.

16,000 Deaths in 2004 because seat belt not worn.
